PATROL & SPECIALTY UNITS

- ↑ 20% increase in DOMESTIC VIOLENCE CHARGES, with 127 in 2023, compared to 106 in 2022.
- ↓ 16% decrease in THEFTS overall (retail, credit cards, and vehicles), with a total of 760 in 2023, down from 903 the previous year.
- ↓ Slight decrease in COMPLETED SUICIDES, with 5 in 2023 and 6 in 2022; however, we had a very slight increase in SUICIDE ATTEMPTS from 145 in 2022 to 148 last year.
- ↑ 33% increase in DRUG OVERDOSES, from 49 in 2022 to 65 in 2023, but ...
- \downarrow 37% decrease in OD DEATHS, from 19 in 2022 to 12 in 2023.
- Drug Task Force investigated 161 complaints of drug activity in 2023, down 10% from 2022, but executed 36 drug related search warrants up 50% from 2022. The largest increase in type of drug seized was cocaine and crack cocaine.
- 354 K-9 deployments, of which 77% were for narcotics searches/detections.
- County's Tactical Unit completed 27 missions; and the Crisis Negotiators Team handled 25.
- The 11 members of our Detective Bureau were assigned 539 cases for investigation; these ranged from child & elderly abuse and sexual assaults to thefts and harassment.
- Weight Enforcement Unit cited 59 of the 73 trucks (81%) for exceeding gross or axel weight limits.

DISPATCH & ADMINISTRATIVE

- ▶ 13 dispatchers took 38,596 CALLS for service a 12% increase from 2022's total.
- ▶ PUBLIC RECORDS requests rose 15%—from 5,446 in 2022 to 6,270 in 2023.
- ▶ 3,920 property items were obtained/logged, a 5% increase over 2022.
- ▶ 211 firearms were confiscated, representing an 8% increase over the previous year.


STAFFING: 247 employees, of which 20% are supervisors.

<u>STAFF BREAKDOWN</u>: 126 deputies, 59 corrections officers, 13 dispatchers, and 49 civilians. 35% of staff are female and 4% are black.

TRAINING: 8,322 hours of training were completed by all staff.

FINANCIALS

The Sheriff's Office 2023 *budgeted* expenditures was \$35,324,309 with *actual* expenditures coming in at \$33,565,964. The charts below show how the expenditures were allocated, with Patrol & Administrative totaling \$23,096,010; Jail at \$9,764,959 and Other at \$704,995.

JAIL & COURT SERVICES

JAIL:

☑ Earned 100% Compliance on the State's annual inspection and achieved PREA Accreditation (Prison Rape Elimination Act) — one of only a handful of Jails in Ohio to do so.

☑ Inmate composition: 72% male, 28% female; 66% white, 27% black, 7% other; 63% reside outside of the County with 36% from Delaware County; 33% of inmates are 30-39 years old, 27% are 18-29 years of age, 26% are 40-49, and the remaining 14% are over 50.

☑ The rate of recidivism (returning to jail) was 26% for those participating in the recovery and re-entry programs; that rate jumped to 55% for the remaining jail population.

☑ 180 volunteers led 2,600 hours of programs for inmates in the jail.

TRANSPORT: 1,855 inmate transports to medical, court, etc.—a 6% increase over 2022.

WARRANTS: 496 arrest warrants were served — an 8% increase.

<u>RECORDS & CIVIL PAPERS</u>: 3,826 civil papers were entered with attempts to serve, which represents a 26% increase over 2022's total of 3,037.

<u>VICTIMS SUPPORT</u>: 339 cases supported in court by our two Victims Advocates — a 22% increase over 2022. Our Advocates also provide services for nine additional law enforcement agencies in the County.

COMMUNITY & OUTREACH

SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICERS taught 22,293 students a total of 829 hours of K-12 safety curriculum & drug prevention throughout 4 school districts in the 2022-2023 school year.

▶ 1,423 CONCEALED CARRY LICENSES were issued/renewed in 2023—up from 1,416 in 2022.

▶ SHERIFF SALES received 37 County foreclosures (up 28% from 2022), with 15 properties sold at an average property sale price of \$377,724 (down from 2022's average of \$801,200.)

▶ 16 residents graduated from our CITIZENS SHERIFF ACADEMY program.

> 520 kindergarten & first graders attended SAFETY TOWN over the summer.

> 90 at-risk youth were served at our annual SHOP WITH A COP program.

> 75 females completed the Women's-Only Self-Defense program, empowered for safety.

> Therapy K9 Otto made contact with 63,000 citizens, including students, the elderly, victims, and first responders, spending an average of 2.77 hours per visit.

- * New Reporting Database: in the fall of 2021, the Sheriff's Office switched to a new reporting system, which impacts how certain incidents are labeled. This makes for some misleading data when compared to previous years, thus, the explanations below are provided to help clarify.
- Domestic—we now take reports only where criminal activity occurred; past years' data included all calls that were investigated.
- Sex Offense—now we include any case where we assisted other agencies in the investigation, not just the Sheriff's Office cases.
- Suspicious Activity/Person—these are now labeled as
 to the actual crime or activity once it was determined;
 previous years were labeled by how the call originally
 came in. These include numerous categories such as
 drugs, unruly juvenile, vandalism, thefts, mental
 health crisis, etc.
- ** Theft of Identity: throughout Ohio and much of the nation in 2021, there was a significant increase in fraudulent unemployment filings.
- *** **Well-Being Check:** this category has continued to increase and is now listed in the annual report.
